In Literacy, we will be learning about the book "Arrggghh Spider!" This is a really fun book and will allow the children to use props and sound buttons to help with retelling the story.

In Maths, we will be focusing on prepositions and subitising. We will learn to follow simple preposition instructions and we will be doing this in forest school on a Tuesday morning. In number, we will be practicing recognising quantities by looking, without counting. This is a difficult skill, but we will practice lots.

We will be continuing our single symbols, ALDs and signing work in communication. Our communication continues to be strong and we hope to see continued progress this half term.
