In Maths this half term we will be starting our new topic on Measurement. This content aims to develop the student's understanding of comparing and ordering lengths, weights and capacity. Students will learn the appropriate units of measurement to use for familiar objects. They will also learn about converting standard units.

In Science we are completing our investigation as part of our coursework for our chemistry unit. We will be finding out which chemical reaction from a selection that we are comparing increases the temperature the most.

In English, the pupils will be completing work to develop their writing skills for the written test for their qualification. We will work on their ability to use writing to give an opinion, to persuade and to inform.

In Humanities we are continuing our places of worship unit focusing on Christian churches/cathedrals. We will be considering the importance of these to Christians and the wider community as well as identifying features of them.

Our computing topic for this half term in spreadsheets. Pupils will be developing their ability to create and edit spreadsheets.
